1. Minutes -

Trustee Mahoney made a motion to approve the May 26 meeting minutes, seconded by Trustee DeYoreo, unanimously approved.

2. Treasurer's Report -

Trustee Mahoney made a motion to approve the treasurer's report, seconded by Trustee Stinson, unanimously approved.

3. Director's Report - Carrie said she is waiting to hear the decision from the reopening task force set up by the state. (Town Manager) Steve Fournier said he'll be opening up town hall soon following CDC guidelines. We will be able to mandate people wear masks when they come in once we open, will also be able to limit the number of people allowed in. Right now Seabrook is allowing five people at a time, eight in Lee. Might be able to mark 6' distances on the floor with tape similar to grocery stores. Also possibly plexiglass over circ desk. Carrie said no one has complained that we are not open yet, other than no access to copier. The town will supply us with masks and hand sanitizer. Perhaps we could start with expanding our hours rather than opening up. Maybe an "ice cream window" so people could come to the window, place orders for books, even get copies made. Will consider options.

4. New business - Trustee Stinson asked if the Friends could purchase a device for hanging paintings. We could display artwork from both the watercolor club and high school students.
