




Blooming Newmarket and the Newmarket Public Library Present:

 Saturday, April 13th at 10:30am




"Just Like Me"

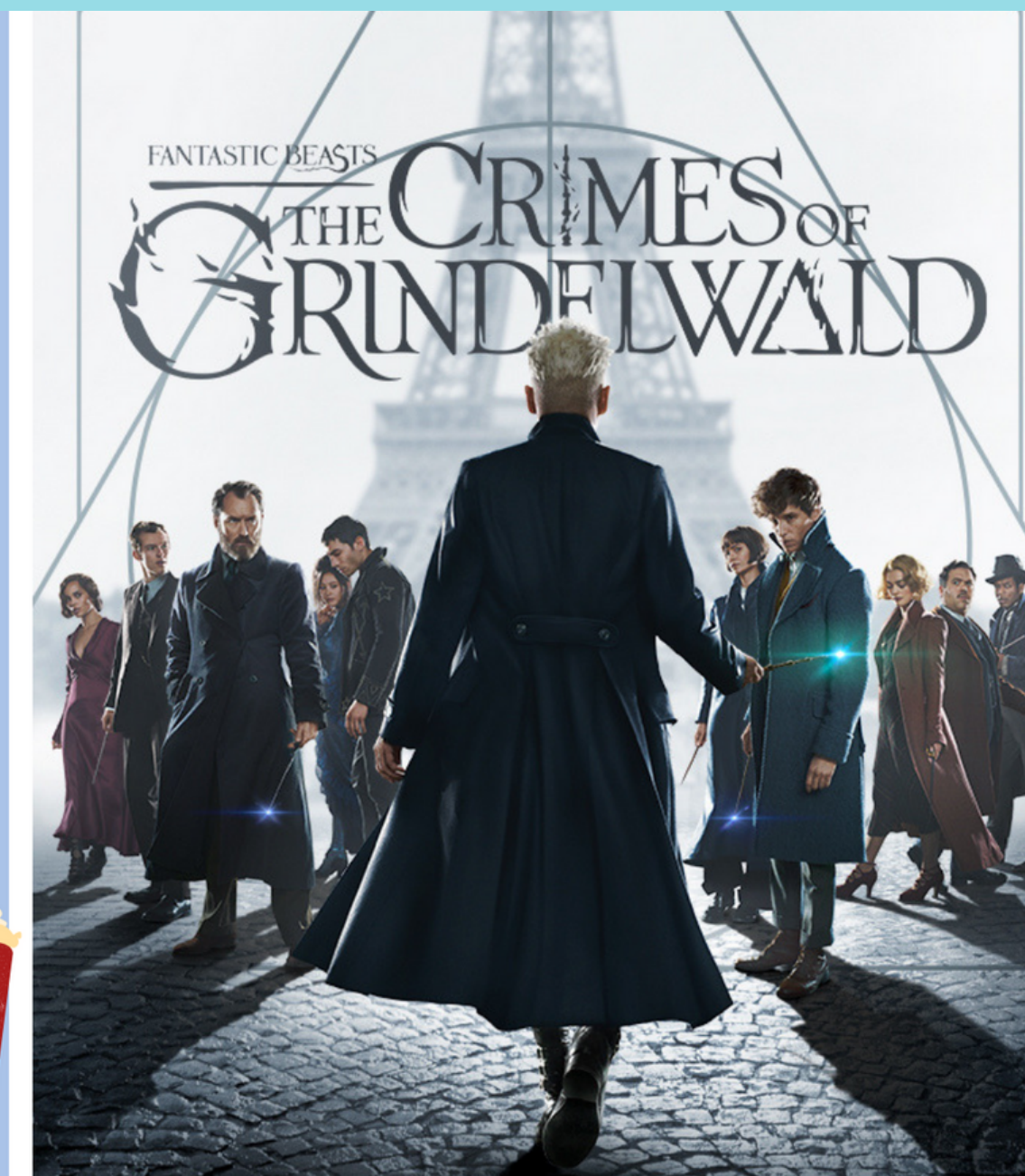

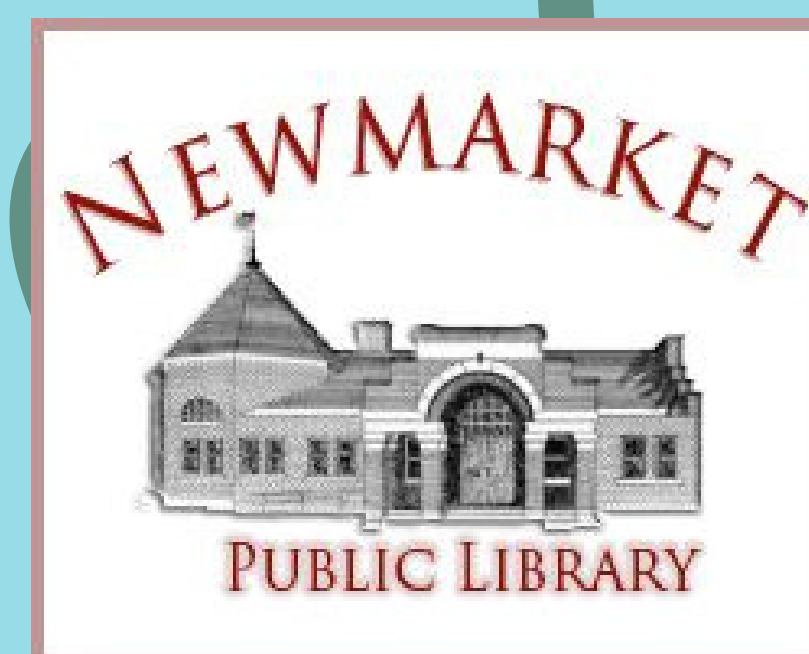
