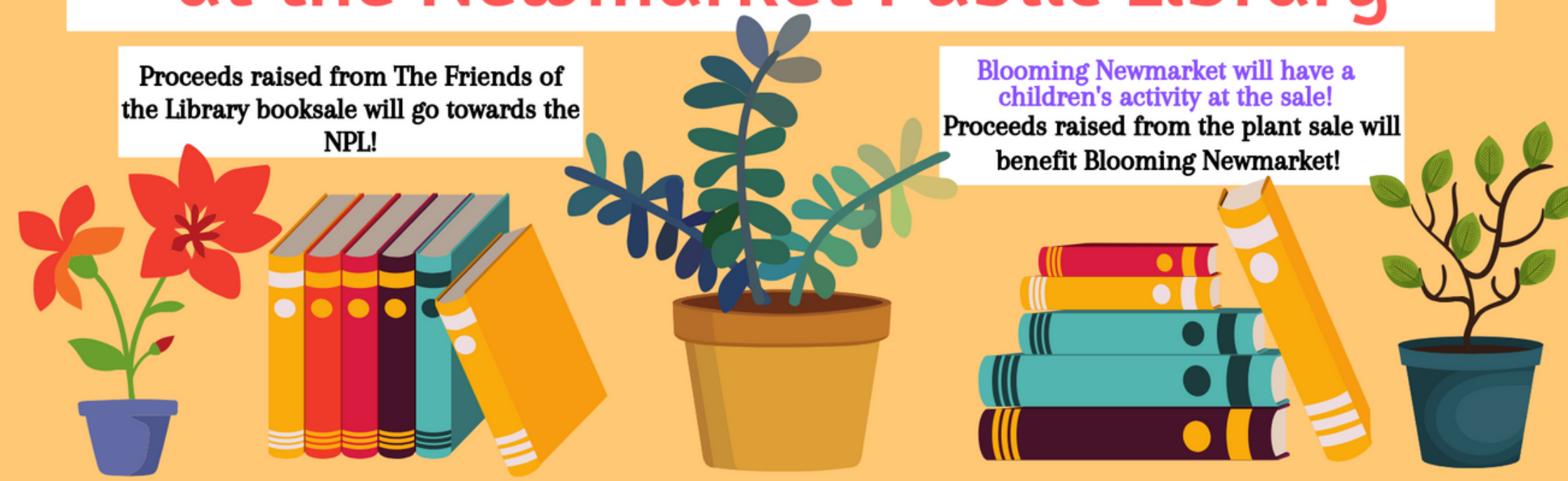


# Book and Plant Sale!

Blooming Newmarket will have a children's activity at the sale! Proceeds raised from the plant sale will benefit Blooming Newmarket!

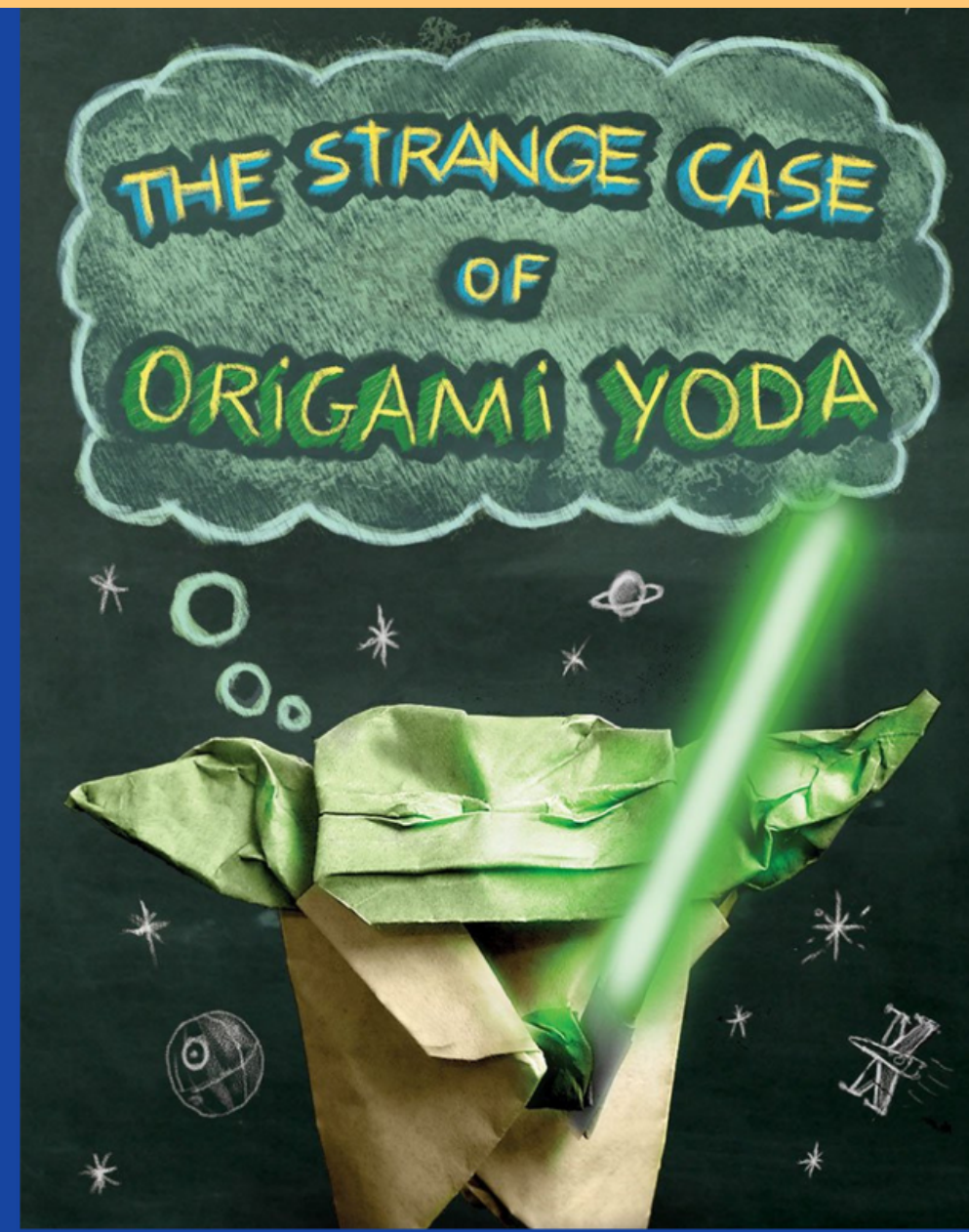
