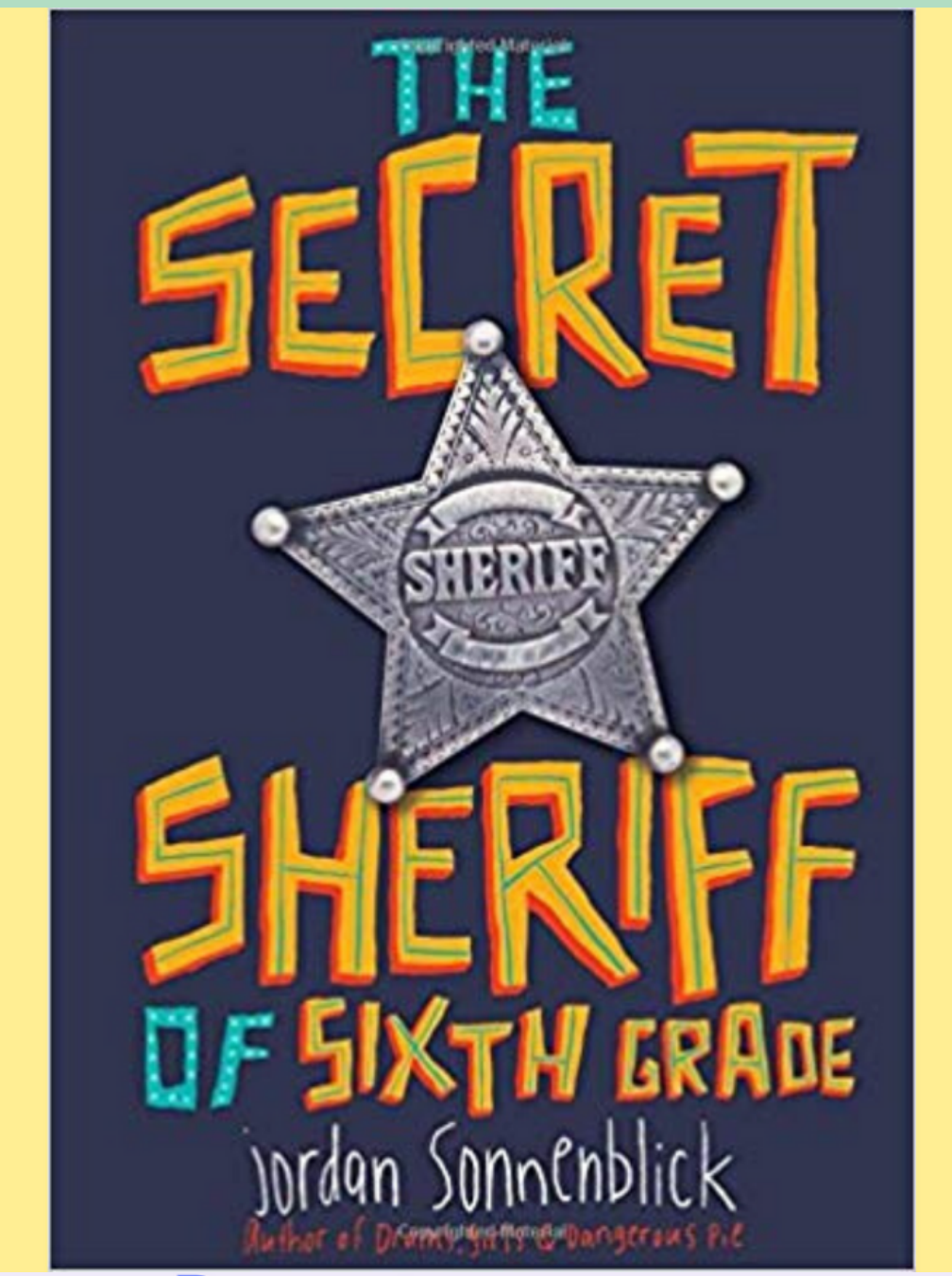

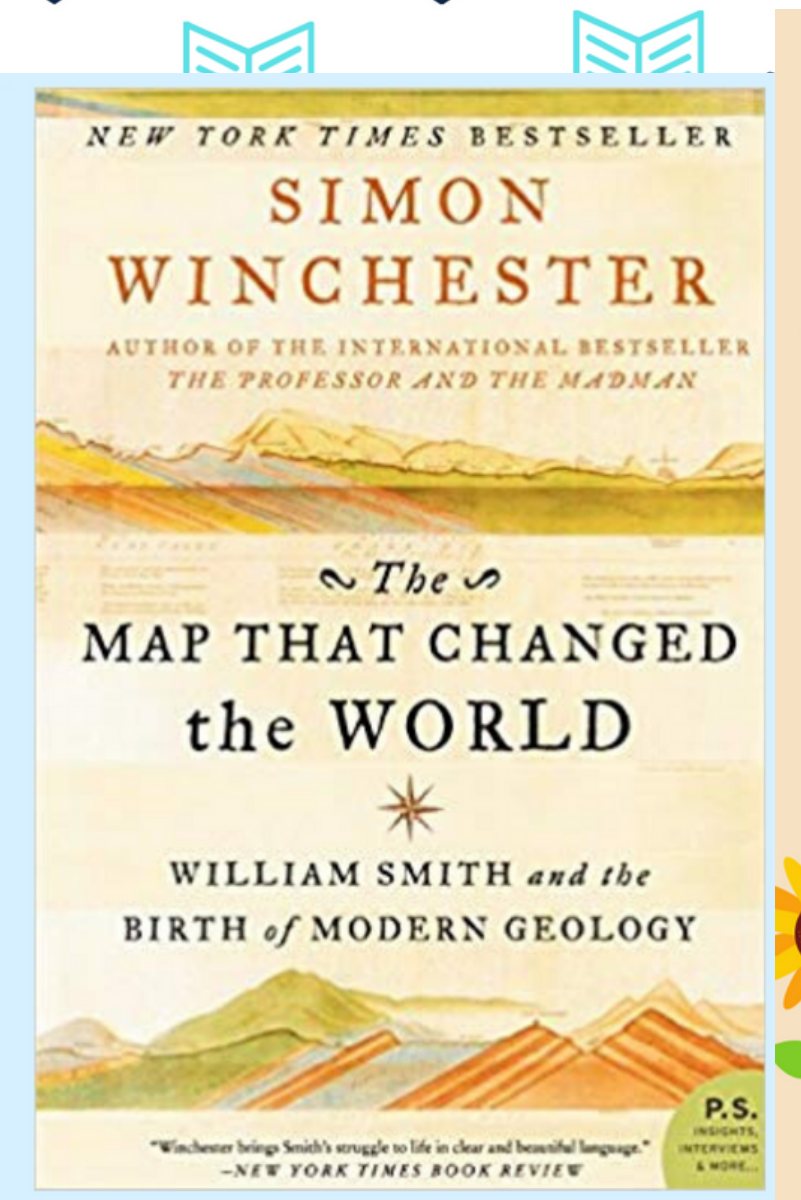

Projects will include a Dirty Pour, Canvas Dip and the Swipe Method. Students will create three different projects!

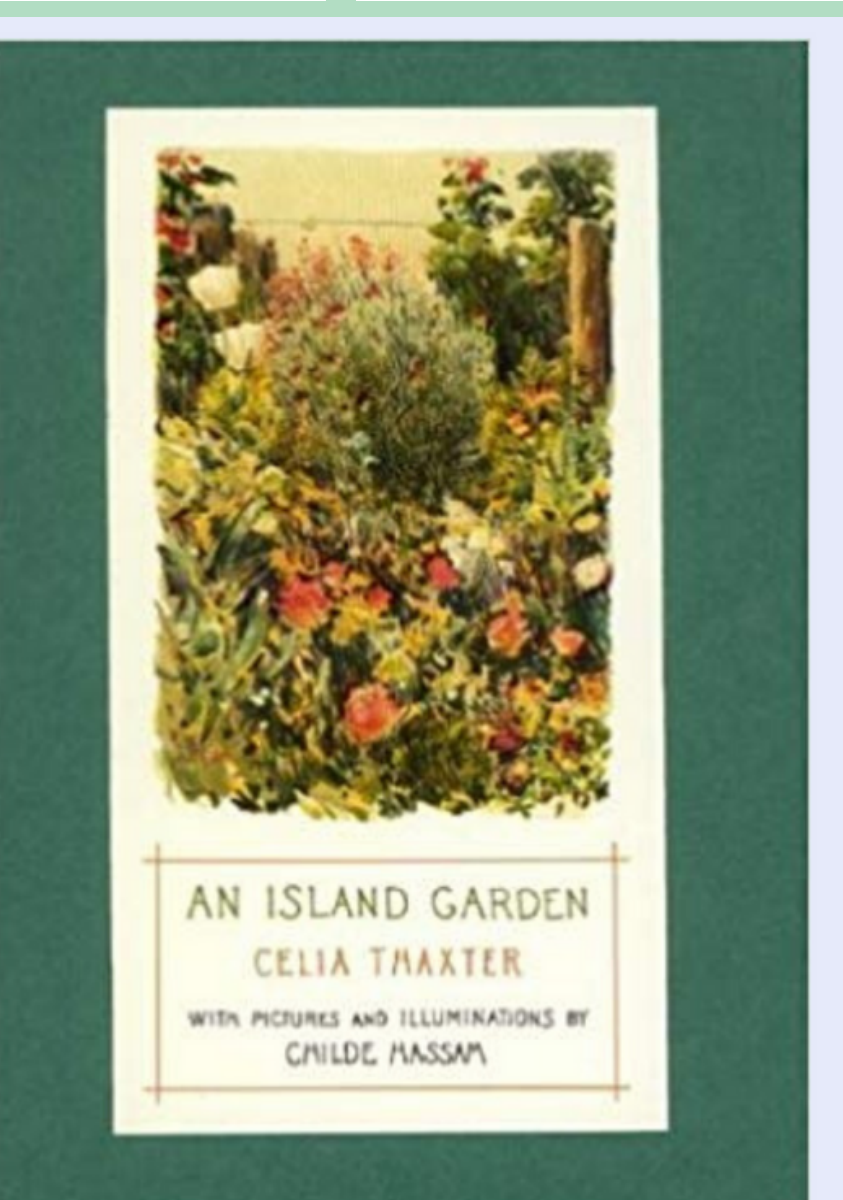

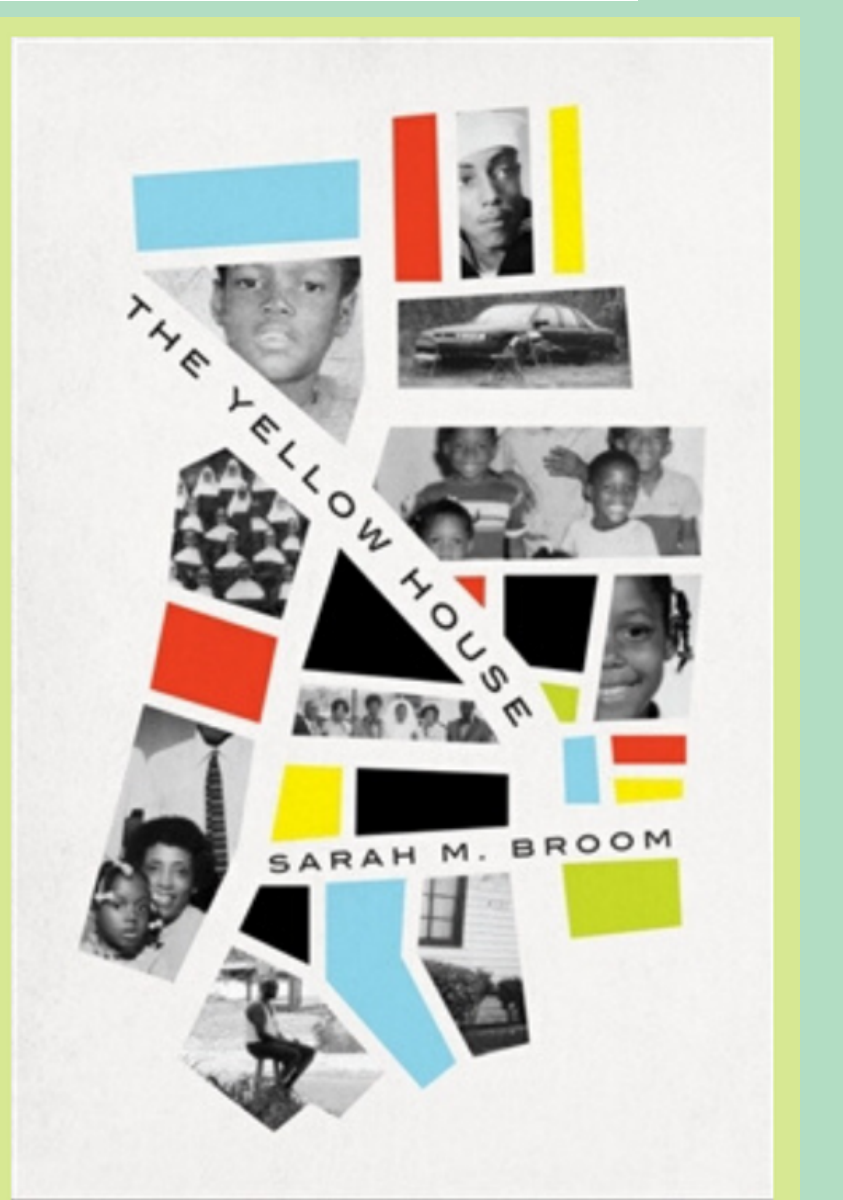
Newmarket Public Library and Blooming Newmarket Present:
