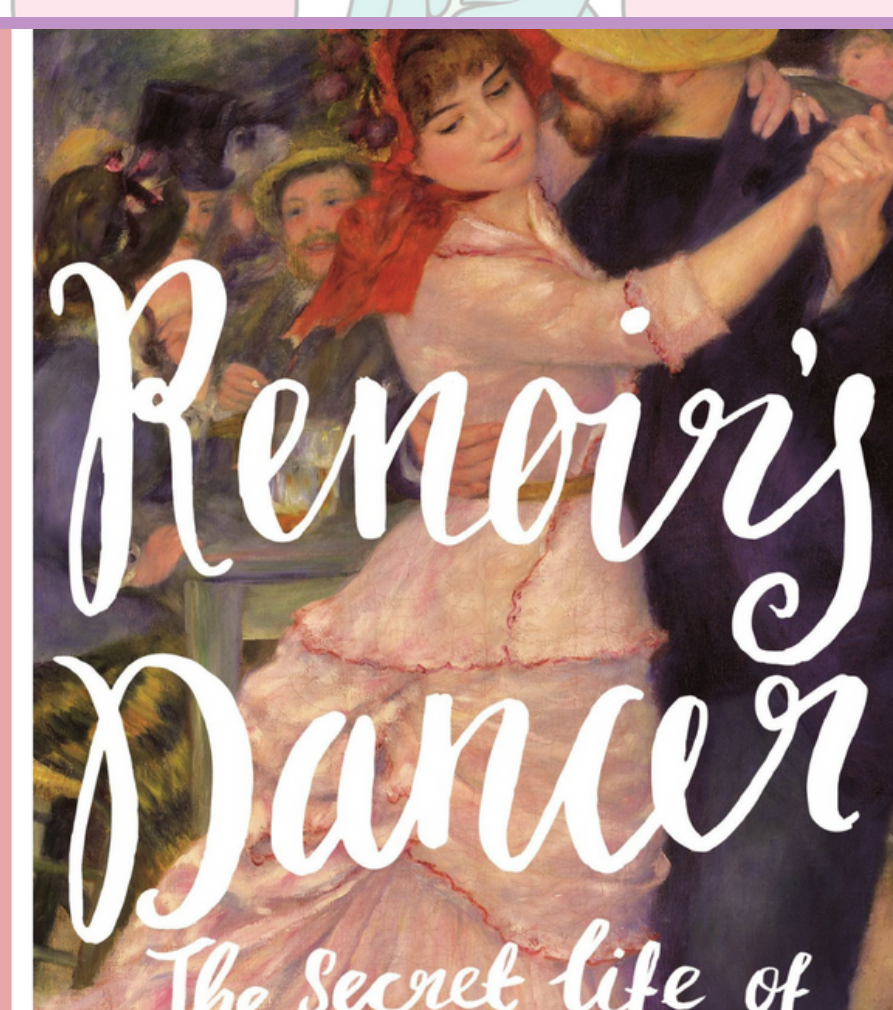

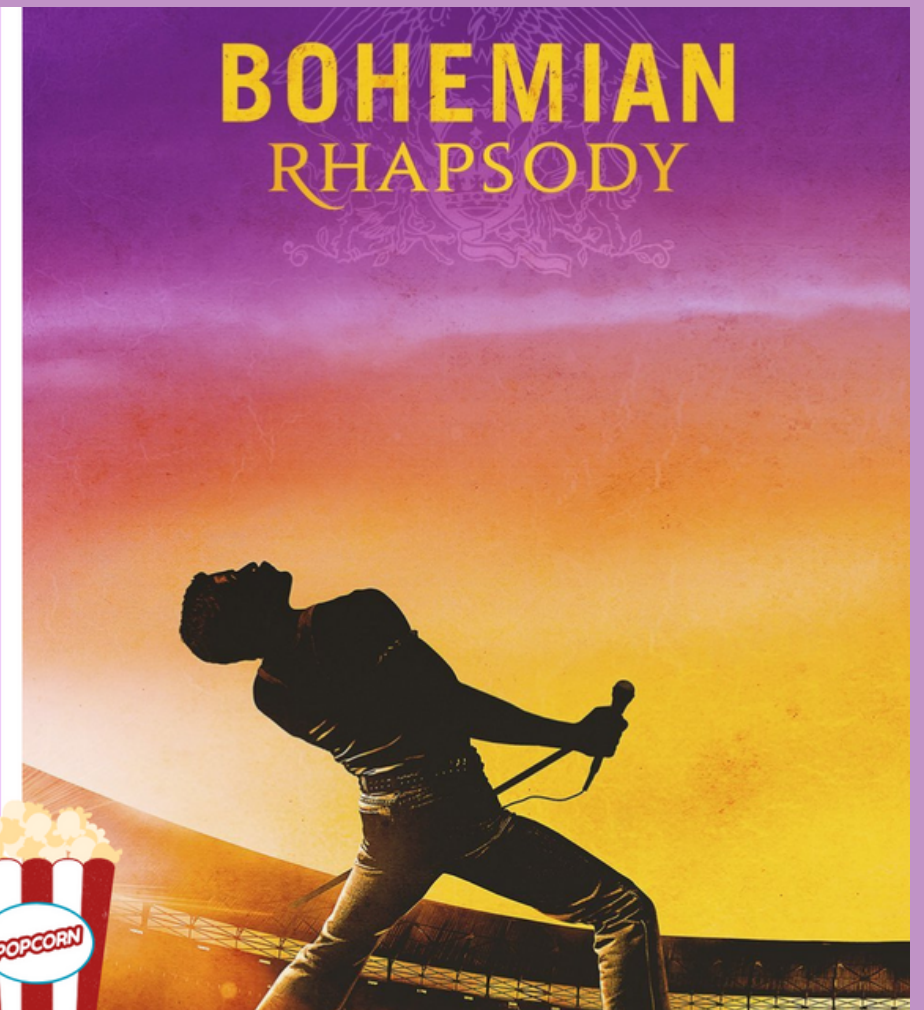

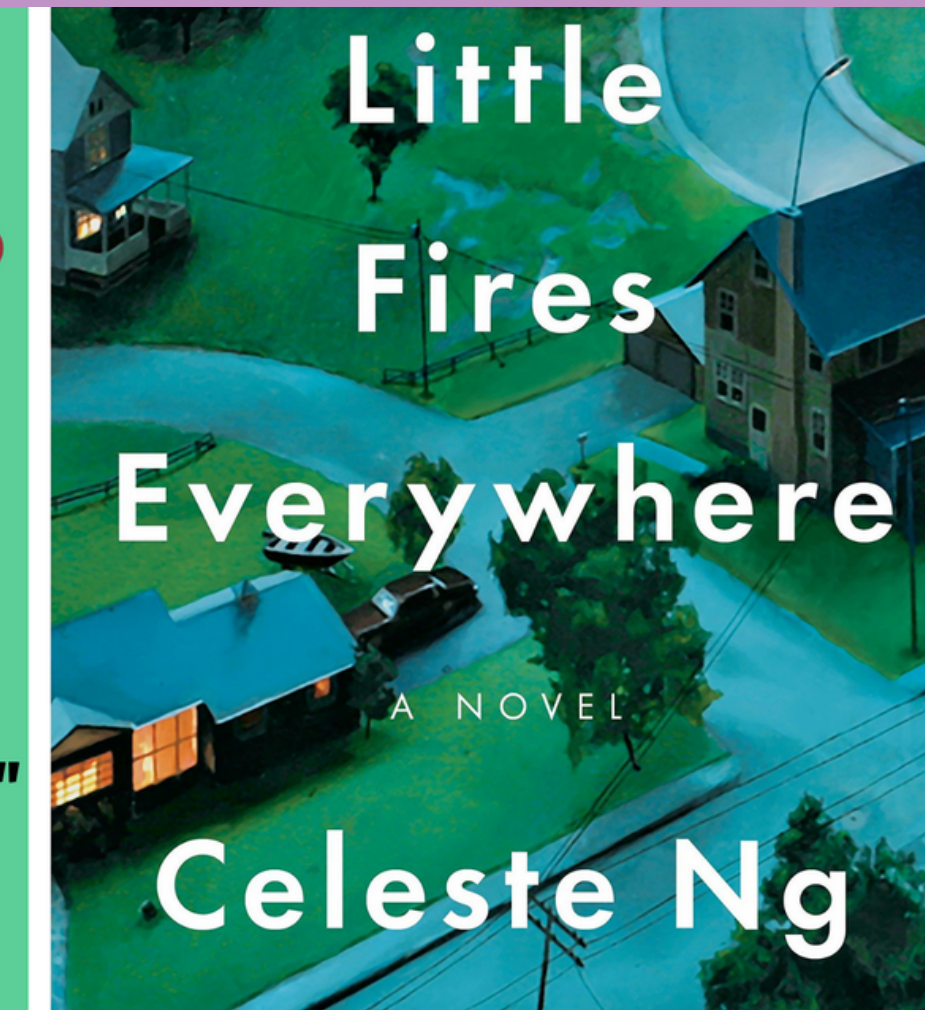

Newmarket Public Library, March 2019

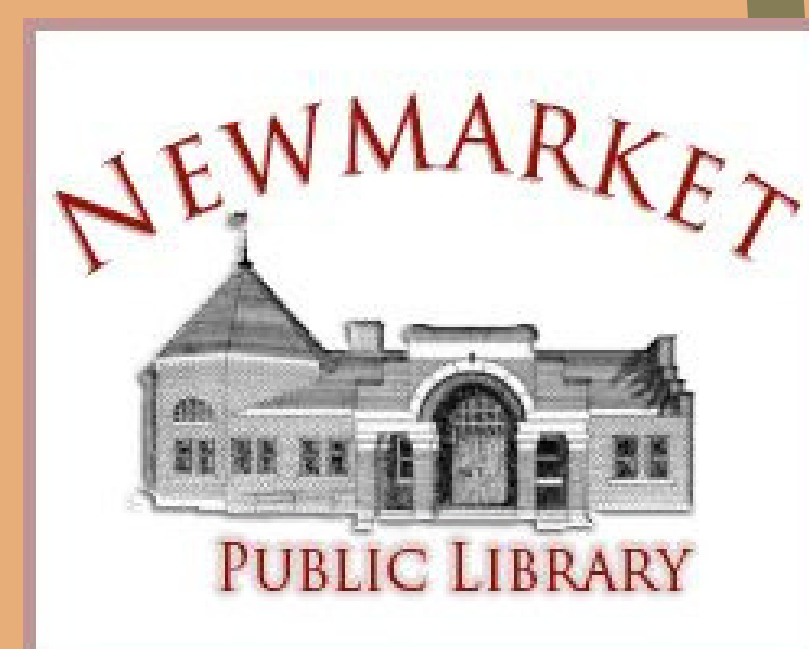


These framed, original prints are on view at Newmarket Public Library for March, 2019.

Artists receive 100% proceeds from any sales of their original work.



Artists at the MindsEye Designs Studio in Dover were asked to think about, "A Lifelong Gift" that they have been given and elaborate on that gift in writing (i.e. "I was given the gift of ____.") They shared ideas and reflections, wrote about their gift and developed a BLOCK letter design of the word as well their own color coded background drawing for reference before transferring, cutting and gluing the word and design with printmaking foam plates -in an 8 by 10 inch printmaking format- for the inking and transfer. Prints were pressed by hand, the best of 3 were selected and framed for this exhibit. These are very limited edition prints. Quality papers are made by Canson and the inks are water soluble.
