- ILL Requests are limited to 5 items per person per week.



To renew a book, or place a hold on a book online you will need to log into our online catalogue

- Go to newmarketlibrary.org
- Click on CATALOGUE
- Click LOG IN in the top right hand corner of the page
- Enter the digits on the back of your library card with NO spaces into the "Library Card Number or EZ Username" section
- Enter PIN # in the "PIN or EZ Password" section
- All library cards are assigned the PIN #9999
- After you have logged in for the first time change the PIN#, or create a username and password
- To reset PIN # please contact the library

To Download Ebooks and AudioBooks you will log into Overdrive - NH Downloadable Books Consortium

- Go to newmarketlibrary.org
- Click on DOWNLOAD BOOKS
- Click SIGN IN on the right hand side of the page
- Select "Newmarket: Newmarket Public Library" from the drop down list
- Then enter your Library Card Number with NO spaces
- Click Sign In. You can begin to borrow items right from your web browser!
- Download the Libby by Overdrive App for your phone or tablet
