INTER-LIBRARY LOAN

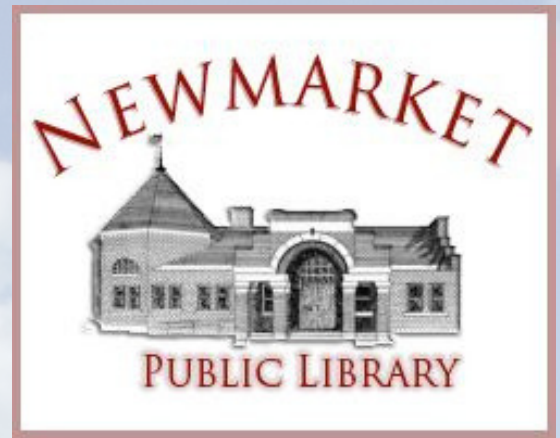

ONLINE CATALOGUE

To renew a book, or place a hold on a book online you will need to log into our online catalogue

- Go to newmarketlibrary.org
- Click on **CATALOGUE**
- Click **LOG IN** in the top right hand corner of the page
- Enter the digits on the back of your library card with **NO spaces** into the "Library Card Number or EZ Username" section
- Enter **PIN #** in the "PIN or EZ Password" section
- All library cards are assigned the **PIN #9999**
- After you have logged in for the first time change the **PIN #**, or create a username and password
- To reset **PIN #** please contact the library

DOWNLOAD EBOOKS

To Download Ebooks and AudioBooks you will log into Overdrive – NH Downloadable Books Consortium

- Go to newmarketlibrary.org
- Click on **DOWNLOAD BOOKS**
- Click **SIGN IN** on the right hand side of the page
- Select "Newmarket: Newmarket Public Library" from the drop down list
- Then enter your **Library Card Number with NO spaces**
- Click **Sign In**. You can begin to borrow items right from your web browser!
- Download the **Libby by Overdrive App** for your phone or tablet
- Read or listen directly from the **Libby App!**
