Learn why it's a creature of our own making! It is smart, beneficial, and by its presence, gives "wild" back to our wild lands.



Coyotes also requires that livestock and pet owners step up to steward our creatures with greater care. Despite the ecological benefits the coyote brings, it is the most persecuted carnivore in North America. Yet it survives and thrives despite efforts to eradicate it.
